APPLICATION

Surfaces must be stable, dry, free of grease and dust, and must not contain adhesive-repellent coatings, some MDF and masonry surface may need a primer coating (such as PHS Primer) for best results. The installer should firstly apply a sample of the tape and test adhesion.
